Agreement for Group Camping Area in Camp Scholler

Name of Group: _____

In consideration for having EAA personnel mark off and secure a specific camping area in Camp Scholler for AirVenture year after year, the requesting Group agrees to the following:

1. The available area for Group Camping will reside south of Lindbergh Ave. and west of Forest Home Ave. Hookup and Handicap sites are not eligible for this Agreement.
2. Group will reserve a minimum of twenty (20) camping sites year to year in a contiguous area, by signing and returning this Agreement as described herein. The number of sites requested may increase or decrease from year to year, but may not drop below 20 in a contiguous area, nor conflict with other existing group camping agreements. Additional sites may be acquired upon arrival on a space available basis and after payment for such sites.
3. An updated version of this Agreement will be required every year. The Group will have the right to reserve the same area each successive year, subject to the conditions of this Agreement.

5. At least one camper per individual camping site credential must be a current EAA member through the end of AirVenture. A list of EAA Members to attend with the Group (who must be current through the end of AirVenture) will be provided in writing to Convention HQ prior to final agreement on total number of sites.
6. The Group Leader (signatory below) will discuss and confirm the exact number of sites with EAA Convention Headquarters in advance. This Agreement (including each annual update) must be fully completed and signed by the Group Leader and received by Convention HQ before Camp Scholler opens to the public.
7. Group will pay the total charges for each site from the opening day of Camp Scholler through the end of AirVenture (normally 38 days), multiplied by the number of agreed sites for the current year. Fees for each site will be calculated based on the standard rates in effect for Camp Scholler in the current year, by type of site. Payment for the agreed number of sites must be received by EAA Convention HQ before Camp Scholler opens to the public. Should payment not be received before the opening day of Camp Scholler the Group's right to reserve its area will automatically become void in the then-current year and subsequent years and the Group's designated area will be released to other groups and/or single campers.
8. Layout and occupancy of the total reserved area is at the discretion of the Group, but number of tents, RV/Trailers and vehicles may not exceed the total number permitted for the aggregate number of rented sites, i.e., the density of equipment and vehicles may not exceed the equivalent of one RV/trailer, or 3 four person tents and one transient vehicle, per site.
9. EAA will provide, deliver, and chain a minimum of one picnic table per every four sites. Rental fees and agreements for additional facilities that may be provided in concert with the Group's sites are at the sole discretion of EAA and will be attached as an addendum to this Agreement, and are void if this Group's reservation right becomes void or is terminated for any reason.
10. The Group Leader or a designee will pick up all credentials and vehicle passes at one time upon arrival.
11. All Group campers must comply with the policies and guidelines stated in EAA's current Campers' Guide. Group agrees to comply with and accept EAA's policies for Special Use Areas should their camping area reside within one of these areas.
12. EAA reserves the right to make exceptions to this Agreement, or to discontinue the Group Camping program, in its sole discretion, with notification prior to Group's payment, in any year. EAA may terminate this Agreement and/or the Group's reservation right for breach of this Agreement, upon written notice to the Group Leader at the address below.
13. The Group Leader signing this Agreement represents that he or she is authorized to sign for the Group, and will notify EAA in writing at EAA's address below upon any change of the Group Leader or contact information below.
